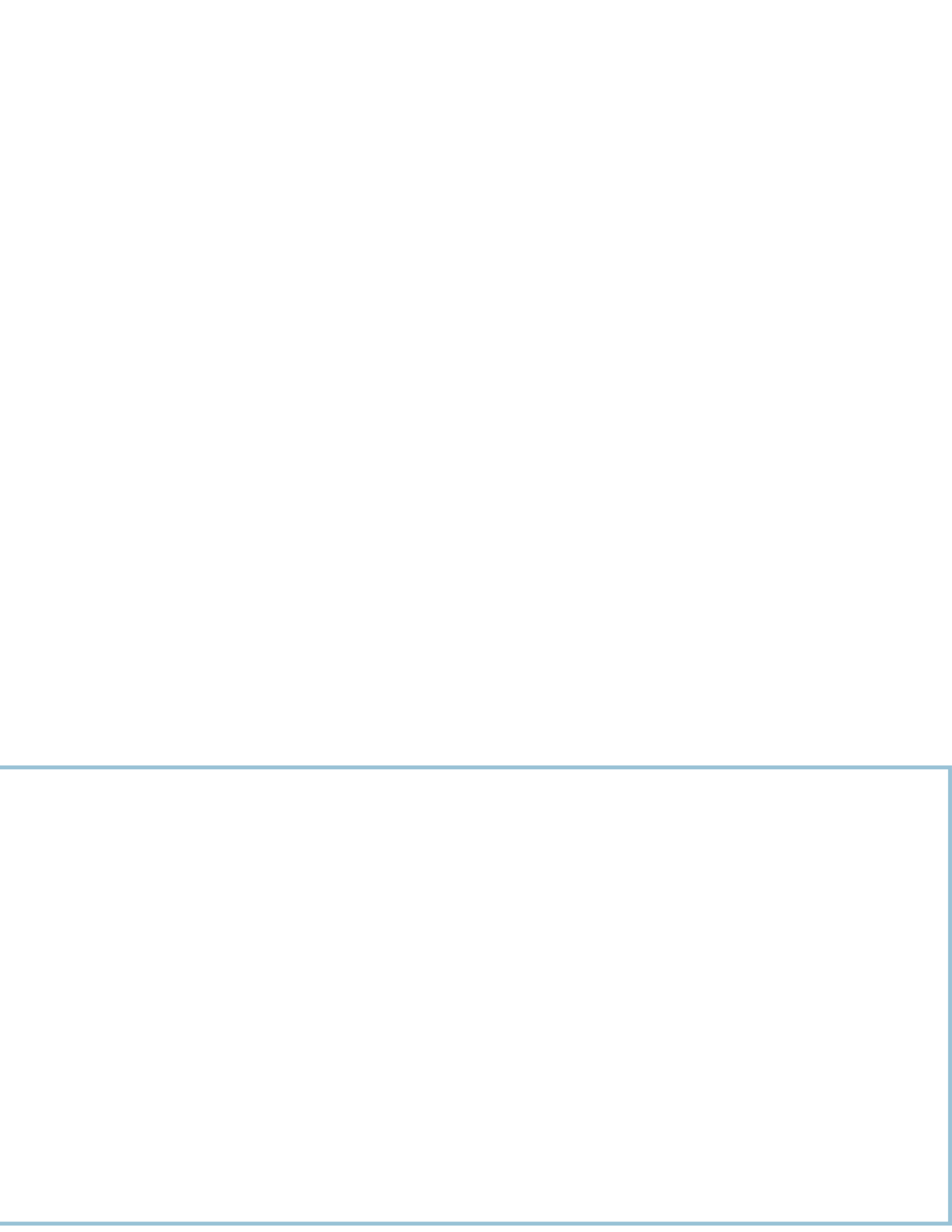

**PASTOR'S NOTES:**

Easter Celebration is over. Perhaps this might have been a very special Easter celebration with a difference. Perhaps all of us has a message from our loving God that He is trying to talk to us through this pandemic. No doubt, there are lots of positive changes that go along with this negative crisis. God is our Creator who has His Master Plan. I believe that nothing, not even a virus, can get in the way of our love for the Lord or our Lord's love for us! In the Letter of St. Paul to the Romans we read, "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose." (Romans 8: 28). Hence Covid19 has its purpose in our lives as we are called by Jesus through the gift of baptism, to be part of his divine life. It is true that we all are suffering from isolation and loneliness. There is a lot of meaning for 40 days of lent, 40 years of wandering in the desert before the chosen people reached the promised land, Moses' spending 40 days on Mount Sinai with God, 40 days of flood where Noah spent time in the Ark, have their biblical meanings, of restoration and of new life. **Information (Cont'd):**

- (2) For the time being we have changed the phone system from multiple lines to single line so that we could leave messages to secretary or get the Rectory phone number and leave message for Catechism coordinator. It has become so simple and easy for any either to leave a message or handle the updates.
- (3) I am trying to connect with parishioners in different ways: by phone calls; attending their pastoral needs by appointment; having Chain Rosary prayer for thirty days ending on April 30; live streaming of Holy Mass on Facebook at 9 am every day and Sunday; Live Divine Mercy Chaplet Novena ending on Divine Mercy Sunday; planning to recite Psalm 91 "Assurance of God's Protection" on next Wednesday after Holy Mass. If we are still unable to connect with someone in the parish, it is because of the lack of their correct and updated information,
- (4) Please update your personal information for the use of the parish directory. Give your name, address, phone number and email id as early as possible. You can call the parish office or leave a paper in the office with your updated details.
- (5) "Zoom Us" is widely used live and payed program. Many of the businesses, schools, and online teachings are using it without any complaint. If any of you is interested to down load it and connect with me for the parish, I may be able to connect with you for live streaming of Holy Mass with your active participation. The benefit is that we both can see each other, give response and participate live from your home.
- (6) If anyone has not received the 2019 tax receipt or has any complaints, please contact me or the parish office as early as possible and try to solve the problem.
