Pastor's Message:

Hope and Courage will help us to live a happy life:

Interestingly every deer can run at a speed of 90 kilometers per hour whereas a tiger can run at the maximum speed of 50 kilometers. In spite of the deer's capacity to outrun a tiger, it becomes a victim of the tiger. Why?

Deer are certain that he is weaker than a tiger and this fearfulness makes him look backwards again and again while running away from a tiger. Naturally every turning back to see the position of the tiger running behind it reduces its capacity of faster speed to lower speed. Not only that, looking back increases its fear of danger. Naturally, losing hope and courage leads any deer to be a victim in front of a tiger.

So, never underestimate yourself. This is what happens with your faith life. When you lose your hope and courage in the Lord, you become a victim of the devil's temptations. Naturally, we become victims of ill health due to our bad habits of excessive drinking, smoking, use of the internet for watching immoral pictures and reading immoral materials. This will make us humans useless persons for ourselves and for others. Remember, Jesus is always waiting for us to help us in whatever way possible. Have faith in the Lord and never lose your courage for spiritual growth in your lives.

Interestingly, the whole world is afraid of the coronavirus, Covid19. It has less attacking power on humans and our immunity power. But weaker human minds are afraid of Covid19 virus causing oneself to lose the battle of life. 99% of the Covid19 death cases are due to weaker minds and weaker immunity power in oneself as well as the presence of other diseases. So never lose courage and hope in your lives. This is applicable for both human and spiritual lives.

Repetition of the past week's message:

Our Christian life is intertwined with seven sacraments of the Church. We begin our life with the sacrament of Baptism and end with the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, the last sacrament. Each sacrament has got sacramental values and they enrich us with sacramental grace.

I invite each of you to write a few words on your birth day or on your marriage anniversary narrating the sacramental effects of baptism or the sacramental effects of marriage in your lives. The main theme should be Jesus' role in your life as you grow up with another birthday or another year of marriage anniversary.

Every Holy Mass is an act of Thanksgiving and our personal offering to the Lord. Birthdays and marriage anniversaries have much importance in our lives. We celebrate them with food, with friends, and with other entertainment. Why can't we think of having a Special Holy Mass offered for us in the act of thanksgiving. Every Holy Mass offered will be a deposit in your account with God.

For people who celebrate their Marriage anniversaries may please write your experience of Jesus' role in your marriage lives, giving more stress on the sacramentality of the marriage. If you are willing to send them to me by an email or a hard copy, with your name or email id, I will be pleased to publish them in our pastoral message column. This might enrich us and others of our parish. If you are not able to write, please give a quote of thought, and I will publish them. This might enrich yourself and others as well.
