

Eucharistic Ministers Set-Up

Fill wine carafe to between 2 and 3 fingers widths.

Check the amount of hosts in the Tabernacle before filling the ciborium.

- **On Saturday estimate about 50 hosts are needed.**
- **On Sunday estimate about 100 hosts are needed.**
- Each sleeve holds 100 hosts.
- It is a good idea to wait until about 15 minutes prior to mass before putting out the wine and ciborium, that way you can gauge the amount of people.
- Father likes the medium host for the top.

Place the ciborium with the pall and the wine on the Entrance Table.

Prepare the tray with:

- Two chalices
- Small carafe with water – fill to full
- Small bowl with warm water
- One Corporal
- Three purificators – one for Father
- One finger towel
- Place the key to the Tabernacle on the tray

Before returning to your seats please clean the chalices at the Credence Table by placing a small amount of water in them and consuming it.

Just a reminder, Eucharistic Ministers process in at the beginning of mass in the procession just after the 2nd Reader. When you process in, please do not carry your purse or your jacket. The 1st Reader will enthrone the Book, wait until he, or she, returns to the front of the altar and then everyone will bow and proceed to their places. Process out at the end of mass in the same order.
