- 1) Since many are happy to return back to the church for our regular Mass and celebrations of the sacraments, and many have shown their interest to clean the church after use, and if we are all positive with this change, we will move back to the church on Monday, September 7th. Secondly we will be starting our catechism classes as early as possible. We need space for our children and we thought to move the church back to its proper place. If the voting following this weekend Masses is in agreement with this change, we will require help to move the church after the Sunday Mass on September 6.
- 2) At present we have Weekday Masses at 9 am and Weekend Masses: Saturday at 5 pm and Sunday at 9 am. and a third Mass at 11:30 which is reserved for the members of Our Lady of Lourdes OK Falls, St. Gregory's Church and anyone incapable of attending 9:00 am mass at Christ the King Parish.
- 3) One washroom has been allocated to use only in absolute emergency. Please disinfect the washroom after use.
- 4) From Monday to Friday there will be **Rosary at 8:30 am and Mass at 9:00 am.**
- 5) **Please try to use our website for any parish news, information, bulletin, homily, etc. until everything resumes to normal.** This might last for a while, none of us can predict.

- 6) Anyone interested to spend time before the Blessed Sacrament in the church or want to have confession are welcome. They need to call, make an appointment and come to church during office hours or by request. They need to use the allotted space and disinfect the place before they leave. In an emergency, call my rectory phone number which is available in the parish office.
- 7) Please turn back your chair when you leave the church.
- 8) Anyone having difficulty in getting up from their chair may please remain seated.
- 9) Music books and Sunday Missals are for your personal use when you attend Mass. Please help yourselves, take one home and ensure your name is on them.
- 10) Weekend Masses on the First Sunday of the month will be dedicated to honor our members who celebrate their birthdays in the month. There will be a special blessing during Mass.
- 11) Weekend Masses on the Second Sunday of the month will be dedicated to honor our members who celebrate their Marriage Anniversaries in the month. There will be a special blessing during Mass.
- 12) The next **Parish Council Meeting**, is on **September 16 at 7 pm**. It is open for all parishioners who would like to attend.
- 13) There will be a **“CWL General Meeting” on September 10 at 7:00 pm**. Please try to attend.
